

PRESS BRIEFING ON ACCREDITATION PROCEDURE FOR THE INTERNATIONAL OBSERVERS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF FOREIGN MEDIA INSTITUTIONS

A. Documents required for the accreditation of the international observers:

- application for accreditation of the person concerned, Romanian or foreign citizen, representative of an international entity with legal personality, written in Romanian, English or French, dated and signed;
- a document stating that the person is designated (mandated, recommended) as international observer by a foreign or international legal entity engaged in the electoral field (application for accreditation, copy of an ID card);
- a copy of an ID document or of a travel document (PEA can require a visa proof for entering Romania, if necessary).

B. Documents required for the accreditation of the foreign media:

- application for accreditation of the journalist, Romanian or foreign citizen, written in Romanian, English or French, dated and signed;
- application for accreditation written by a foreign media institution, in Romanian, English or French, stating that the journalist is employed by the respective editorial as a correspondent during the Parliamentary elections of December 11;
- freelance journalists will submit a request for accreditation from a foreign media institution or from the board of a foreign media association to which they belong, certifying that they are journalists;
- a copy of the journalist ID card;
- a copy of an ID card or travel document (PEA can require a visa proof for entering Romania, if necessary).

Note: The representatives of the foreign media institutions who already have a correspondent valid license issued by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs will send to PEA only the accreditation application.

The documents can be sent by fax, post or email, or they can be submitted to the Registration Office of PEA.
